**Restoration.** This year's Lent theme is *Restoration*. Our world seems so broken and worn out. Relationships are severed. We have frayed minds and torn hearts. We feel lost and alone and disconnected from one another. What we need most of all is for God to restore us. We need God to find us where we are and bring us back to where we belong. We need restoration in our homes and in our communities. We need our faith to be restored, and that can only come through the promise of Jesus Christ. During Lent, we encourage you to participate in restoration in any of the following ways:

- 1) Restoration Amid Hurricane Damage. Donate diapers, wipes, baby formula (for the Early Learning Coalition of Northwest Florida) backpacks, notebooks, ruled paper and pencils (for students in Calhoun County), money for the Blountstown Chorus to rent a bus to participate in the district MPA's (need \$384), money to "raise the roof" of First Presbyterian Marianna's food pantry (need \$5000), and money to replace the septic tank at First Presbyterian Marianna (need \$2700). Money can be placed in the offering plate during Lent, with hurricane restoration on the memo line; items can be placed on the pallets in the sanctuary. Thanks to you, we have already raised \$3800 toward t these items.
- 2) Restoration through Personal Devotion. Enjoy scripture, meditation and photography using visio divina as your devotional guide. The book, Awakening to God's Beauty, is \$3.75, and available from Pam Mills in the church office (pam@faithpcusa.org). Families can use the Lent-in-a-Jar devotional guides. Adults can join Faith Formation on Wednesday, March 13 to create a painting reflecting on restoration in Christ.
- 3) Restoration through a Lenten Book Study, A Dangerous Dozen by C.K. Robertson. Faith Formation, Wednesday evenings, March 27—April 17. Books, available from Pam Mills, or at Faith Formation on March 27, are \$17.00. In this book meet 12 fascinating at times, intimidating Christian change agents who were unafraid to ask what God would have them do in the face of life's realities, and unafraid to go ahead and do it. Their words and actions challenged the status quo, and in so doing, they showed the face of Jesus to the Church and to the world.

Church Workday. Bring the family, water bottles, gloves, and tools/equipment to help spruce up the buildings and grounds on Saturday, April 6. There are both indoor and exterior jobs, big and small jobs. Our goal is to get Faith looking great for our Easter guests. We'll gather at 8 a.m. for coffee and donuts in Fellowship Hall, but feel free to join us whenever you can.
